Project Requirements.

1. **Must use template provided.** Cut the three tabs to make three separate regions.

2. Information needed:

- a. May work with 2 other people (One in charge of a region).
- b. ESP-ECONOMIC, SOCIAL, POLITICAL write of the region. What was it like to live there prior to the American Revolution. No current state info, this is the colonial era!!!!
- c. The Early History Cornell Section should include who founded the colony and when founded in the A. line and in the B. line should have one interesting fact that you think makes the early history of that colony stand out. What should we remember?
- d. The front tab should have the names of the colonies.
- e. The back of the paper should have the regions colored in and you must make symbols for the main economic activities of the region. Put in key and on map. Make sure to fill in color of regions in key too.
- f. Be ready to explain your region/early history during a teacher/student led gallery walk.
